Elk Hunt Gear List- Rifle

This list is just a recommendation of what you should bring if you are planning to come to Wyoming to rifle elk hunt. If there is something else you think you should bring, by all means, go ahead and bring it since it is a drive-in camp. Wyoming has some tough weather and terrain, so we like to make sure you have an idea of what to expect while you are here.

- Hunting License & Conservation Stamp
- Hunter Safety Card- If born after January 1st, 1966
- Rifle: 270 Caliber or larger, zeroed at 200 yards
 - We ask that you practice at 300-500 yards
 - 50 rounds of ammunition for hunting and sighting in after traveling
- Binoculars- 8x42 or 10x42
- Range finder
- Day Pack
 - Capable of carrying all of your gear
- Headwear- ball cap, stocking cap and neck gaiter
- Fluorescent orange- cap or vest
- Base Layer- Light to Medium weight
- Mid Layer- Fleece jacket or pullover, wool shirt, synthetic sweatshirt
- Outer Layer- Medium weight coat, water resistant preferred
- Rain Gear- Light packable rain jacket
- Pants- Bring two (2) Pairs. Make sure they are water resistant.
- Gaiters
- Socks- Light and medium weight hiking socks that are good quality. Wool or synthetic are best.
- Boots- A good pair of hiking boots is very important with the type of terrain you will be in. Keep the weather in mind as it may be cold and wet.
- Gloves- bring a heavy pair and a couple of light weight pairs.
- Headlamp- bring an extra set of batteries
- Sleeping bag- 0-degree bag
- Toiletries
 - Chapstick
 - Tooth brush
 - Tooth paste
